Save the Storks operates a robust medical mobile unit program and collaborates with pregnancy centers, ensuring women receive the essential services they need and deserve. Their effectiveness is evidenced by the fact that over eighty percent of abortion-minded women choose life after witnessing an ultrasound of their unborn child—a powerful testament to the impact of their work.

In the face of rising abortion rates, particularly evident in the seventeen percent increase in Colorado in 2021, Save the Storks remains dedicated to combating this trend. The

organization's goal for 2024 is to raise funds for an expanded mobile medical bus, extending its reach from the Denver metro to Colorado Springs and addressing the critical needs of women facing unplanned pregnancies.

Save the Storks is launching their 100th medical mobile bus this month, December 2023. The busses reach across thirty-four states, serving over thirty-three thousand clients. These Stork Medical Buses empower local pregnancy centers to broaden their reach and directly bring the transformative beauty of an ultrasound to women, making a lasting impact on their choices.

Beyond reproductive healthcare, Save the Storks focuses on maternal/child health and extends its mission by connecting clients with vital resources necessary to bettering the life of both mother and child. The holistic approach of Save the Storks educates and empowers women, men, and children and uplifts our entire community.

The organization's tireless efforts have significantly contributed to the well-being of our local community, exemplifying a dedication to creating a culture of life not only in El Paso County but across America.
