### Next Steps for the Church







The Church needs to be talking about matters of life, sex, unplanned pregnancy and healing from abortion in a deeply compassionate way. There is tremendous shame and isolation for those who face unplanned pregnancy— especially in the church. We need to create ways of opening honest conversations where those who need the community of Christ know they will be loved, healed, supported and restored.



Often women feel as though they're a victim of their circumstances (i.e. poverty or an unstable relationship) and feel like abortion is their only choice. Likewise, 79% of women are not sufficiently informed about resources that would help them if they chose life. This is where the church can powerfully make a difference.
